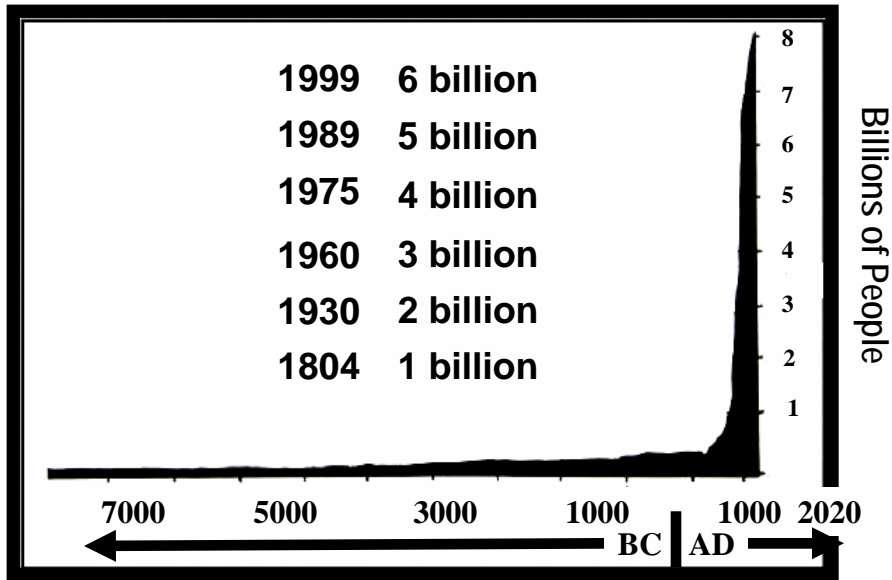

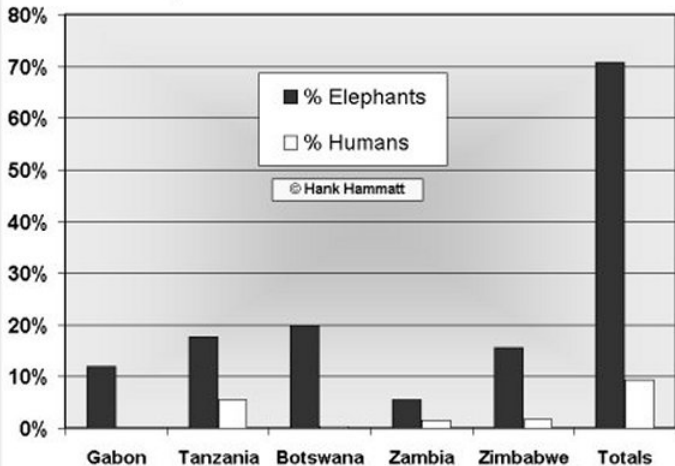
Quick & Easy Ways to Save Paper (and Trees!)

- 1) In your Word program, go to *File>Page Set-up>* and click on the *Margins* tab. Change the margins (top, bottom, left, right) to 0.9 inch (or lower). Now go down to the default tab and click on that. Make these settings your permanent default settings. This will save hundreds or thousand of sheets of paper over the lifetime of your computer. Trees saved.
- 2) Tell everyone you know to do the same thing and tell them to tell everyone they know. Forests saved. Elephants saved.
- 3) Always use recycled paper.
- 4) Re-cycle the paper you do use.
- 5) Make double-sided copies.
- 6) Campaign to have your local newspaper stop publishing the final quotations of stock, bond, and mutual fund prices (often 8 newspaper pages). Astute traders get their quotes over the Internet anyway. Now you're saving the Earth!



Human Population Explosion

**Elephant - Human Populations in Range Countries of Africa -
> 70% of Elephants Found in Countries with <10% of Humans**



Note: 70% of African elephants are found in home range countries with just 10% of the African human population

Since 1950, humans have consumed more resources than in all of previous history combined!

Ecological Footprint accounting shows that, as of October 9th, humanity has already consumed the total amount of new resources nature will produce this year.
